

## HEERF II and III FUNDS QUARTERLY REPORTING

### CRRSAA and ARP REPORTING ON EMERGENCY FINANCIAL AID GRANTS TO STUDENTS

Enid Beauty College (OPE ID 021265) received education stabilization funds under the CRRSAA and ARP programs. This Fund Report applies to the student portion received under the Higher Education Emergency Relief Funds II and III (HEERF) that is designated exclusively for emergency financial aid grants to students.

The following information is reported for the period, October 1, 2021 to December 31, 2021.

The institution is making the below information available for transparency purposes and in compliance with the U.S. Department of Education's ("Department") Electronic Announcement and Guidance.

1. The Institution signed and returned to the Department the Certification and Agreement and assurance that the institution has used or intends to use the applicable amount of funds designated under the CRRSAA and ARP programs to provide Emergency Financial Aid Grants to Students.
2. The total amount of funds that the institution has received from the Department pursuant to the institution's Certification and Agreement for Emergency Financial Aid Grants to Students under the CRRSAA and ARP programs is \$64,848. (HEERF II \$40,892 and HEERF III \$23,956)
3. The total amount of Emergency Financial Aid Grants distributed to students under the CRRSAA and ARP programs as of the date of submission (January 10, 2022) is \$64,848. All funds have been depleted.
4. The estimated total number of students at the institution that are eligible to receive Emergency Financial Aid Grants to Students under the CRRSAA and ARP programs is 22.
5. The total number of students who have received an Emergency Financial Aid Grant to Students under the CRRSAA and ARP programs is 22.
6. The method used by the institution to determine which students receive Emergency Financial Aid Grants and how much they would receive under the CRRSAA and ARP programs. (see Attachment A)
7. Any instructions, directions, or guidance provided by the institution to students concerning the Emergency Financial Aid Grants.(see Attachment A)

Attachment A: **HEERF II and III Student Emergency Funds**

Enid Beauty College understands that many of our students have been struggling financially due to the impact that the COVID-19 pandemic has caused. For this reason, the college applied for a Higher Education Emergency Relief Fund (HEERF) Grant, funded by the recently passed Coronavirus Response and Relief Supplemental Appropriations Act. It provides emergency funding to colleges to provide financial aid grants to their students. Enid Beauty College applied for these emergency relief funds on behalf of its students.

**Enid Beauty College is pleased to be able to help our students who may be facing financial challenges.**

HEERF II and III emergency grant monies may be used by the student to help cover expenses related to their cost of attendance such as tuition, food, housing, utilities, health care (including mental health care), transportation, child care, or for emergency costs due to coronavirus. The purpose of the emergency funds is to provide aid to higher education students to address the unexpected expenses and losses associated with the coronavirus pandemic.

**Eligible students are students who are currently enrolled as of the day the funds are drawn down. Students must be a U.S. citizen or eligible non-citizen.**

The HEERF II and III monies will be distributed to students that meet certain requirements set by the U.S. Department of Education. Unlike the CARES ACT, the CRRSAA requires that institutions prioritize students with exceptional need when awarding HEERF II and III grants, such as students who receive Federal Pell Grants. However, students who are not Pell recipients are still eligible. Eligibility is not conditioned on the students continued or future enrollment in school.

**Enid Beauty College has defined exceptional need for the purpose of these funds based on two populations:**

- *Group 1* - Pell eligible students
- *Group 2* - Non-Pell eligible students

**Amount of awards:** *Group 1* - Pell eligible students - This group will receive the highest HEERF II and III Award.

*Group 2* - Non-Pell eligible students - This group will receive a lower HEERF II and III Award.

- Amounts disbursed to students may vary depending on the number of enrolled students.
- The school determined Pell eligibility from using the students most recent EFC code on file at Enid Beauty College.
- Funds will be disbursed by check directly to students.
- These are one-time grants from the federal government and do not need to be repaid.
- Each student must sign acknowledging that they have accepted the grant funds and will use the funds for the intended purpose.

**The funds were disbursed in the following manner:**

The school received \$40,892.00 in HEERF II funds and \$23,956.00 in HEERF III funds for a total of \$64,848.00. In the 2<sup>nd</sup> quarter of the 2021 calendar year \$30,600.00 of this grant was disbursed. In the 3<sup>rd</sup> quarter of the 2021 calendar year there were no funds disbursed. In the 4<sup>th</sup> quarter \$34,248.00 of the HEERF II and III funds were disbursed to eligible students. A total of \$64,848.00 has been disbursed to eligible students and the HEERF II and III funds have been depleted.
